Research, Patents and Publications:

4. For Research, Patent and Publications, the members appreciated the progress in the research article publications which are indexed in Web of Science and Scopus and suggested to include this as a parameter in Faculty's annual appraisal form as a motivation to the faculty members performing well in research. Members also suggested to monitor the citations and indexing of research articles published by faculty members as well as the institution, since it is one of the vital parameters considered in NIRF Ranking

Course Delivery and Assessments:

- 5. Members suggested to have senior faculty members to teach the core subject of first year so that the students can have a clear perspective on the concepts related to their branch of study.
- 6. Members had the discussion on the weightage of internal assessment and end semester examinations as either 50:50 or 60:40 for the autonomous curriculum and finally agreed to stick on with 60:40 at this stage to cope up with the assessment process of the affiliating University.

Examination Process:

Members of the Governing body suggested to check with the affiliating university for the possibility to get the permission to conduct supplementary examinations within a month of release of End semester examination results, to facilitate students to clear their backlogs and become eligible for the placement process.
